AN ACT

Relating to special hazard insurance for employees of the state; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE 3. SPECIAL HAZARD INSURANCE.

Sec. 39.30.130. SPECIAL HAZARD INSURANCE. Upon the request of any state department, the Department of Administration may procure insurance, in addition to workmens compensation insurance, for employees of the department against accidental death or dismemberment occasioned by special hazards in connection with their employment.

* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.050(7) is repealed.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
