**AN ACT**

Relating to workmen's compensation.

---

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

\* Section 1. AS 23.30.175 is amended to read:

Sec. 23.30.175. RATES OF COMPENSATION. (a) Compensation for temporary disability or permanent partial disability may not exceed \$127 a week and may not be less than \$25 a week. If the employee's average weekly wages, as computed under sec. 220 of this chapter, are less than \$25 a week, he shall receive as compensation for temporary disability his average weekly wages.

(b) In computing compensation for permanent total disability the average weekly wages are considered to have been not more than \$127. If the average weekly wages as computed under sec. 220 of this chapter are less than \$25 a week he shall receive as compensation for permanent total disability his average weekly wages.
