AN ACT

Appropriating to the Department of Public Works, division of aviation; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$1,422,000 is appropriated from the international airport revenue fund to the Department of Public Works, division of aviation, to supplement existing appropriations for international airport expansion projects at Anchorage and Fairbanks as follows:

Additional costs of providing a 400' x 1,000' gravel extension to the light aircraft parking apron, a 100' x 4,000' gravel taxiway and base course construction on a 325' x 1,325' apron, in lieu of paving an existing gravel apron at the Fairbanks International Airport	\$ 84,000
Carpeting at Fairbanks International Airport	15,000
Added costs of terminal expansion at Anchorage International Airport	768,000
Added costs of terminal expansion at Fairbanks International Airport	555,000

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
