HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 17

Commending Alaska Airlines for furnishing transportation for the newspapers provided the legislature.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Alaska Airlines furnishes transportation, at no charge to the legislators, for the newspapers which are provided to the legislature; and

WHEREAS this fast service is of great value to the legislators who must rely to a great extent on the newspapers for their knowledge of daily statewide events and public opinion; and

WHEREAS, by transporting the newspapers for the legislature, Alaska Airlines is performing a commendable public service;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature commends Alaska Airlines for bringing the state's newspapers to Juneau as a public service.
