HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 19

Commending Secretary of the Interior Walter J. Hickel for his courageous stand against the alienation and polarization of the nation's young people.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS Secretary of the Interior Walter J. Hickel, in a recent letter to President Nixon, demonstrated rare insight into some of the grave problems which face our nation today; and

WHEREAS in a time of increased dissatisfaction with America's course in world and national affairs and the resulting polarization of and dissension between groups of American citizens, Secretary Hickel's call to the administration for moderation, deeper understanding and better communications was indeed refreshing and uplifting; and

WHEREAS Walter J. Hickel has himself answered a deep-seated mood of the American people by courageously and in a statesman-like manner pointing out to President Nixon the means to truly "bring us together";

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska House of Representatives hereby commends and congratulates Secretary of the Interior Walter J. Hickel for his courageous stand on behalf of the young people of the United States and against their further alienation from the viable democratic processes.
