HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 24

Relating to state occupancy of BIA-owned education facilities at Mount Edgecumbe, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS there is a need for a regional vocational-technical post secondary-adult school in Alaska; and

WHEREAS the local public high schools could utilize the facilities of such a school to a significant degree; and

WHEREAS there are certain existing facilities that could be adapted for use as a regional vocational-technical post secondary-adult school; and

WHEREAS the BIA is planning construction of a dormitory for the 200 students who will be attending the Sitka Public High School, thus creating a vacancy in the facilities at Mount Edgecumbe; and

WHEREAS the state will fund the construction of classrooms for the Sitka Borough to house the 200 students;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the State Departments of Education and Public Works to investigate the feasibility of assuming the operational responsibility of the BIA-Mount Edgecumbe Schools with the intention of maintaining a regional vocational-technical post secondary and adult training school for selected senior high school students, post secondary, and adult citizens of the State of Alaska.
