SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 10

Relating to the extension of Armed Forces television to certain areas of the state.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the solution of the vast communications problems of Alaska has been made an item of the highest priority by both the legislative and executive branches of government; and

WHEREAS different aspects of these problems are being attacked at various levels of state government; and

WHEREAS the goal of the numerous approaches is the ultimate integration of all communications into one modern, comprehensive, efficient system; and

WHEREAS recently, through an agreement between the Department of Defense and the state, an arrangement has been worked out, contingent upon legislative appropriation, whereby facilities to be located at Naknek and Dillingham would utilize Armed Forces television programming from the King Salmon Air Force Base to provide television to much of the Bristol Bay area; and

WHEREAS it is conceivable that this same type of arrangement could be worked out for other areas of the state where Armed Forces television is available; and

WHEREAS the communications hardware used to provide this service could be later integrated into an overall communications network for Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Public Works to analyze the feasibility of providing Armed Forces television to areas, other than
