SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

Honoring the late Lieutenant General (Ret) Frank A. Armstrong, Jr.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS on August 20, 1969, the State of Alaska lost a true friend and great supporter with the death of Lt. Gen. (Ret) Frank A. Armstrong, Jr.; and

WHEREAS General Armstrong led an outstanding and active career in the United States Air Force from 1928 until his retirement in 1961, a career replete with many acts of bravery, heroism and at all times distinguished by service in the finest traditions of this nation's armed forces; and

WHEREAS, as Commander of the Alaska Air Command from 1949 until 1961, General Armstrong had a major part in the history of Alaska's development;
