SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 3

Recommending the early approval of direct jet flights from Anchorage to Kenai, Homer, Kodiak and Seattle.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS Western Airlines has announced discontinuance of air service to the communities of Kodiak, Homer and Kenai; and

WHEREAS present service from Anchorage to Kenai, Homer, Kodiak and direct to Seattle has generated a large and ready market for Alaskan seafood products in Seattle and other west coast cities; and

WHEREAS continuance of air service between Anchorage, Kenai, Homer and Kodiak direct to Seattle is necessary and desirable for the convenience and well-being of the residents of these communities;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Civil Aeronautics Board is urgently requested to approve applicants wishing to provide direct jet service between Anchorage, Kenai, Homer, Kodiak and Seattle so that service between these communities may not be interrupted.

COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Secor D. Browne, Chairman, Civil Aeronautics Board; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
