SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 7

Proposing that the Governor seek emergency aid from the United States Coast Guard in an attempt to stop the present illegal crab fishery taking place in the Aleutian Islands area.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS certain unknown parties are presently engaged in the unlawful taking of crab in the Aleutian Islands area; and

WHEREAS this has been verified by aerial reconnaissance of the area; and

WHEREAS there are no enforcement vessels belonging to the state in the area, thus making it impossible to apprehend the violators;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate urges the Governor to contact the United States Coast Guard for emergency vessel assistance in transporting fish and game enforcement personnel to the area so that an end can be put to this flagrant violation of Alaska's fishery conservation regulations.
