AN ACT

Relating to civil liability for giving counseling or advice to persons in a condition of emotional crisis.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 09.65.090(a) is amended to read:

(a) A person who, without expecting compensation, renders care to an injured or sick person, or gives counseling or advice to a person in a condition of emotional crisis, who appears to be in immediate need of aid is not liable for civil damages as a result of an act or omission in rendering emergency care, counseling or advice or as a result of an act or failure to act to provide or arrange for further medical treatment or care for the injured person or further counseling or care for the person in a condition of emotional crisis.
