AN ACT

Prohibiting alienation and attachment of assistance provided under the Aid to Families with Dependent Children Act; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 47.25.395. ALIENATION AND ATTACHMENT. Assistance granted under secs. 310 - 420 of this chapter is inalienable by assignment or transfer and is exempt from garnishment, levy, or execution under the laws of this state.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
