AN ACT

Relating to the accumulation of annual leave.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.20.240 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.20.240. ACCUMULATION OF ANNUAL LEAVE. The annual leave which is not used by an officer or employee accumulates for use in succeeding years until it totals not to exceed 60 days at the end of the calendar year, unless his department or agency head certifies in writing that the employee or officer was denied the opportunity to use leave accumulated in excess of 60 days between January 1 and December 31 of each year. The Department of Administration will promulgate regulations and forms to insure proper annual leave control.
