AN ACT

Relating to the definition of public utility.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. PURPOSE. It is the finding of the legislature that it is necessary to avoid unnecessary regulatory procedures over petroleum fuel dealers delivering to trailer courts and apartment buildings having local pipe distribution systems for heating fuel, and whose owners or residents have a choice of suppliers.

* Sec. 2. AS 42.05.701(2)(E) is amended to read:

(E) furnishing for distribution or by distribution petroleum or petroleum products to the Alaska public for compensation when the consumer has no alternative in his choice of supplier of a comparable product and service at an equal or lesser price;
