AN ACT

Relating to methods of attending meetings by corporate officials.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 10.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 10.05.199. ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS. Unless prohibited by the articles of incorporation or a bylaw, the members of the governing body of a corporation, including a bank, or a committee designated by it can validly conduct a meeting of their respective groups by communicating simultaneously with each other by means of conference telephones or similar communications equipment.
