AN ACT

Relating to the Alaska remote housing program; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Ch. 212, SLA 1968 is amended to read:

Sec. 1. In anticipation of a federal appropriation of \$10,000,000 to the people of Alaska by the federal government under Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966), the Department of Administration is authorized to make available to the agency designated by the Governor under ch. 93, SLA 1967, the sum of \$1,000,000 as the state's share in financing the cost of preparing, administering and implementing the Alaska Native Housing Program authorized by Title 10, Section 1004, Public Law 89-754, 80 Stat. 1285 (1966) and implemented by ch. 93, SLA 1967. However, if the United States Congress fails to appropriate at least \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year to the Alaska Native Housing Program, the Department of Administration is authorized to make available to the agency designated by the governor under ch. 93, SLA 1967 an amount up to \$1,000,000 for that fiscal year in order to assure if possible a total remote housing program of up to \$1,000,000 for each fiscal year.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
