AN ACT

Relating to the licensing of commercial fishermen; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.450(a) is amended to read:

(a) The commissioner of revenue or his authorized deputy shall issue a license to each qualified person who files a written application in person, at places in the state designated by the commissioner, containing the reasonable information required by the commissioner together with the required fee. The application shall be simple in form and shall be executed by the applicant under the penalty of perjury.

* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.450 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(c) A commercial fishing gear license for a specific registration area may be issued only within the specific area for which the license is requested.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1972.
