HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 27

Relating to the construction of a new high school on Prince of Wales Island.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there is a need for a new high school to be constructed for students in the Prince of Wales Island area; and

WHEREAS the area between Craig and Klawock near Klawock Lake offers unique and superior advantages for the new school; and

WHEREAS this site not only is already accessible by road, but is accessible by small aircraft, along with having the potential of an excellent water system; and

WHEREAS it is anticipated that in the near future the existing road will be extended all the way to Hyدابurg which would further make Klawock Lake an ideal site for the school; and

WHEREAS the Klawock Lake site would also afford the school ample opportunity for future expansion as needed and is suitable for related athletic facilities and other extracurricular activities;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Education to undertake an immediate feasibility study for a new high school in the Klawock Lake area.
