HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 29

Relating to the encouragement of small businesses in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Small Business Administration is authorized, under the provisions of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.A. 631 et seq.), to execute agreements with other federal agencies wherein contracts or awards for the sale of government property would be made to small business; and

WHEREAS the Small Business Administration has entered into an agreement with the Department of Agriculture wherein timber tracts may be set aside for sale to small business;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that, in order to encourage and promote small business in Alaska, the Small Business Administration and the United States Forest Service are requested to set aside, within the National Forests of Alaska, timber for sale to qualifying small businesses.

Senators, and the Honorable Nick Begich, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
