HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 11

Commending the Naval Security Group Activity at Elmendorf Air Force Base.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS, in response to a call for volunteers, seven petty officers assigned to the Naval Security Group Activity at Elmendorf Air Force Base, Alaska, painted one of the cottages at The Jesse Lee Home, an institution for emotionally disturbed children at nearby Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the volunteer effort of the Navy personnel from Elmendorf, the cottage, consisting of eight bedrooms, a living room and dining room, was painted in less than six hours and readied for occupancy at a date earlier than anticipated; and

WHEREAS this selfless expression of civic spirit reflects credit not only on the Navy personnel who volunteered their time for this needed community project, but also speaks well for the concern of the United States Navy for the communities in which its men and women are stationed;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the State of Alaska that it commends the Naval Security Group Activity at Elmendorf AFB, Alaska, for its generous response to this request for volunteer help.
