SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 13

Commending various newspapers for providing papers to the legislature.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS several Alaska publishing companies have made their newspapers available to the Legislature free of charge; and

WHEREAS this service has been of great value to the legislators by increasing the opportunity for each member to broaden his knowledge of statewide events and public opinion;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Seventh Legislature of the State of Alaska commends the following newspapers and sincerely thanks those responsible for making the papers available: KETCHIKAN DAILY NEWS, FAIRBANKS DAILY NEWS-MINER, ANCHORAGE DAILY NEWS, SOUTHEAST ALASKA EMPIRE, TUNDRA TIMES, ANCHORAGE DAILY TIMES, KODIAK MIRROR, NOME NUGGET, ALASKAN FARMER, ISLAND TIMES, THE VALDEZ COPPER BASIN NEWS, SEWARD PHOENIX LOG AND SITKA SENTINEL; and be it
