SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16

Relating to assistance of the Legislature at the fifth annual Boys' State.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the fifth annual Boys' State program will be held on the campus and facilities of the Copper Valley School near Glennallen, Alaska, in June 1971; and

WHEREAS at Boys' State the delegates learn the duties of the various offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the election of a legislature, and the introduction and debate upon bills in accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

WHEREAS the Legislature, as in past years, could be of valuable aid to the operation of the Boys' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs Agency prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legislative process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members in attendance at Boys' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature direct the Legislative Council to authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency to assist in the preparation of legislative materials and, on request of the Boys' State chairmen, to have legislators designated by the presiding officer of each house and two Agency staff members attend the fifth annual Boys' State to aid the delegates in the legislative program.
