SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 44

Relating to the proposed Barrow airport complex.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Sixth Legislature of the State of Alaska included in its capital improvement program a combined facilities building program for Barrow, Alaska; and

WHEREAS it has been determined that the proposed state building for Barrow should be included in an airport complex building to be built by the City of Barrow for the following reasons:

- (1) lower cost of construction
- (2) availability of water and sewer
- (3) lower cost of heating
- (4) central location; and

WHEREAS, in view of these facts, it would be uneconomical to proceed on the basis of the 1970 authorization with the state leasing these facilities from the Alaska State Housing Authority;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Legislature of the State of Alaska that it authorizes the Department of Administration to enter into an agreement with the City of Barrow for the leasing of space in the now proposed Barrow airport complex and authorize funds necessary for this agreement.
