AN ACT

Prohibiting the unauthorized use of the symbol of the Arctic Winter Games and the unauthorized representation of connection with the Arctic Winter Games.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. (a) No person may use, display or publish the symbol of the Arctic Winter Games, consisting of the triple circle symbol and ulu combination, for commercial purposes or private gain without the written authorization of the Arctic Winter Games Incorporated.

(b) No person may use, display or publish any name, title or device that tends to indicate that he is affiliated with or supported by the Arctic Winter Games without the written authorization of the Arctic Winter Games Incorporated.

(c) A person who violates a provision of this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100. Each day of unauthorized use, display or publication is a separate offense.
