## AN ACT

Relating to the Tourism Advisory Board.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. AS 44.45.110 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.45.110. COMPOSITION AND TERM OF OFFICE. The Tourism Advisory Board consists of nine members appointed by the governor for overlapping three-year terms.

- \* Sec. 2. AS 44.45.120 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 44.45.120. COMPENSATION, PER DIEM, OR EXPENSES. Members of the Tourism Advisory Board are not entitled to receive compensation for their services, but they shall receive the same travel pay and per diem as provided by law for board members for attendance at a maximum of two meetings each year.

- \* Sec. 3. AS 44.45.130 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.45.130. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. One member of the board shall be either the executive director or another officer of the Alaska Visitors Association. The remaining eight members of the Tourism Advisory Board shall be persons with experience or interest in the Alaska tourist industry.
