AN ACT

Relating to notary public seals; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.50.080 is amended to read:

Sec. 44.50.080. SEAL. (a) A notary public shall provide and keep an official seal, upon which shall appear the words, "State of Alaska" and "Notary Public," together with the name of the notary. He shall authenticate all official acts with his seal.

(b) The seal of every notary public whose commission is issued on or after July 1, 1972 may be affixed by a seal press or stamp that will print or emboss a seal which legibly reproduces under photographic methods the words "State of Alaska" and "Notary Public" and the name of the notary. The seal may be circular not over two inches in diameter, or may be a rectangular form not more than an inch in width by two and one-half inches in length, and shall contain the information required by this section.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1972.
