AN ACT

Relating to the establishment of the Alaska Native language center at the University of Alaska.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 14.40.117. ESTABLISHMENT OF ALASKA NATIVE LANGUAGE CENTER. The university shall establish an Alaska Native language center, the purposes of which are to:

- (1) study languages native to Alaska;
- (2) develop literacy materials;
- (3) assist in the translation of important documents;
- (4) provide for the development and dissemination of Alaska Native literature; and
- (5) train Alaska Native language speakers to work as teachers and aides in bilingual classrooms.

Actual effective date: October 4, 1972
