AN ACT

Relating to the number of members on the Board of Directors for State-Operated Schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. AS 14.08.030 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.08.030. APPOINTMENT OF THE BOARD. There is created the Board of Directors for State-Operated Schools consisting of nine members to be appointed by the governor from the areas served, subject to confirmation by the legislature; at least six members shall be appointed from rural school areas outside of military reservations and organized boroughs.

- * Sec. 2. AS 14.08.060(b) is amended to read:

(b) Five members constitute a quorum but a smaller number may adjourn from day to day for a period of not exceeding 10 days.
