## AN ACT

Relating to boards of equalization within organized boroughs; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 07.15.320 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(e) The borough assembly sits as a board of equalization for the purpose of hearing in the manner provided for first class cities any appeal from determinations of the borough assessor, or it may delegate this authority to a board appointed by it for that purpose. The board of equalization shall consist of that number of members of the assembly over and above the number required for a quorum to transact business. The board is governed in its proceedings by such procedures consistent with general rules of administrative law and the laws governing equalization proceedings in first class cities as may be adopted by ordinance, including but not limited to quorum, and voting requirements.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
