## AN ACT

Relating to licensure to practice medicine.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 08.64.200(2) is amended to read:

(2) submit a certificate of graduation from a legally chartered medical school accredited by the Association of American Medical Colleges and the Council on Medical Education of the American Medical Association;

\* Sec. 2. AS 08.64.270(a) is amended to read:

(a) The board may issue a nonrenewable temporary permit to an applicant for licensure by endorsement or by examination who meets the requirements of sec. 200 or 205 of this chapter and pays the required fee.

\* Sec. 3. AS 08.64.270(c) is amended to read:

(c) A temporary permit issued to an applicant for licensure by examination is valid until the results of the first examination for which the applicant is scheduled are published. If the applicant fails to take the first examination for which he is scheduled his temporary permit is revoked on the day of the examination.

\* Sec. 4. AS 08.64.380(3)(F) is amended to read:

(F) violating the Controlled Substances Act, P.L. 91-513, or any other federal law pertaining to medical practice and drugs;
