## AN ACT

Relating to the discharge of firearms from, on, or across highways.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.55.065. SHOOTING FROM, ON, OR ACROSS HIGHWAYS. A person who discharges a firearm from, on, or across a highway is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in jail for not more than one year, or by both. In this section "highway" means all highways (whether included in federal-aid primary or secondary systems), roads, road rights-of-way, streets, public trails, walks, bridges, tunnels and other similar or related structures or facilities.
