HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 11

Honoring Roderick M. MacKenzie.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS word has been received of the recent passing of Dr. Roderick M. MacKenzie, in Victoria, British Columbia; and

WHEREAS Dr. MacKenzie, for a period of over 30 years made his home in Southeast Alaska, and traveled thousands of miles throughout Alaska aiding persons with dental problems at a time when professional dental services in Alaska were few and far between; and

WHEREAS he was dedicated to the economic and social well-being of all Alaskans and was especially active in numerous civic affairs in his chosen towns of Ketchikan and Petersburg; and

WHEREAS Dr. MacKenzie served his community and state ably as a member of the Territorial Senate from 1949 - 1951;
