HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 12

Honoring 15 State of Alaska employees.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, on September 4, 1971, 15 State of Alaska employees were among the 111 persons who died in an airlines crash in the Chilkat Mountains of Southeast Alaska; and

WHEREAS these employees -- exemplary and dedicated Alaskans all -- included Francis Bernard, John Doyle, Mary Doyle, Harvey Golub, Christina Jacobsen, Dennis Jacobsen, Lorenz Kaufman, Hugh Knickerbocker, Robert Nafus, David Osvald, Frederic Riech, Mary Rogers, Clinton Schilstra, Raymond VanNess and Michael Wade; and

WHEREAS most of these employees, representing four departments and ten divisions, were traveling on official business for the State of Alaska at the time of this disaster; and

WHEREAS these employees have been, and are, sorely missed both professionally and personally by their colleagues in state employment and by their friends in the state legislature;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh State Legislature that this resolution serve as an expression of the deep, continuing sorrow which members of the legislature feel at the loss of each of these public servants, and as conveying the legislature's most sincere and heartfelt condolences to the families of these employees.
