HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 17

Honoring Eugene H. Schaefer.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Eugene Schaefer recently met an untimely death; and

WHEREAS for many years Eugene Schaefer's devotion and love of music has been instrumental in providing Anchorage residents with the finest of musical entertainment as performed by the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra; and

WHEREAS over a period of sixteen years, he served as manager, librarian, board member, secretary of the board and in every other conceivable capacity with the Anchorage Symphony Orchestra; and

WHEREAS over the years Eugene Schaefer donated literally thousands of hours to the development of the symphonic music program in Anchorage, all without compensation to himself other than the knowledge that people were able to listen to and enjoy the symphonic music he loved so well; and

WHEREAS he also selflessly devoted other countless hours to his duties as a member of the Alaska Festival of Music Board and as a staff member of the Kings Lake Music Camp;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature expresses its most sincere belief that Eugene Schaefer will be long remembered as a leader in the development of the Anchorage symphonic music programs and that his memory is cherished by all who have ever enjoyed concert music; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature extends its sincere condolences to the family of Eugene H. Schaefer.
