HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 40

Honoring Rueben Crossett.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Rueben Crossett has for some time been instrumental in sponsoring Rueb's Wild Game Dinner in Ketchikan; and

WHEREAS these dinners are famous statewide for the abundance of delectable wild game offerings; and

WHEREAS Alaskans from all areas of the state have seen fit to travel to Ketchikan to attend Rueb's Wild Game Dinner and it is growing each year by leaps and bounds; and

WHEREAS these dinners are given for the purpose of raising money for charity alone, and one in particular being the Ketchikan Children's Home; and

WHEREAS between 1969 - 1971 the Ketchikan Children's Home has received the approximate sum of \$3,000 as a result of the Wild Game Dinner fund raising and this year more than \$3,000 was taken in;
