HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 62

Commending and extending best wishes to the Reverend Mark A. Boesser.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas community and the members of the Alaska Legislature were stunned and saddened to learn that the Reverend Mark A. Boesser will resign from the pulpit of the Church of the Holy Trinity (Episcopal) in Juneau at the end of June; and

WHEREAS Father Boesser and his wife, Mildred, then will move to Cambridge, Massachusetts, where he will begin a year's fellowship at Episcopal Theological Seminary; and

WHEREAS since his arrival in Juneau in December, 1959, not only has Mark Boesser ministered to the spiritual needs of the Episcopalians in that city, but also, ever a good shepherd, the entire community has been his flock; and

WHEREAS Father Boesser frequently served as Chaplain both to the House of Representatives and to the Senate; and

WHEREAS in that capacity his offerings of prayer each morning frequently were provocative and invariably were uniquely thoughtful; and

WHEREAS the Boessers, whose four daughters were graduates of the Juneau-Douglas schools, are much beloved by the community and will be sorely missed in Juneau and in Alaska;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska warmly commends the Reverend Mark A. Boesser, Rector of the Church of the Holy Trinity (Episcopal) for his stewardship of that parish, his enthusiastic leadership in the Juneau community

and for his service to the State of Alaska, noting particularly his inspirational contribution to the annual sessions of the Alaska Legislature as Chaplain in both houses, and extends best wishes and Godspeed to Father Boesser and his wife, Mildred, as they embark on their year of study and reflection in Cambridge and in all of their future endeavors.
