HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8

Honoring Lester Bronson.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Lester Bronson, former state and territorial legislator has met an untimely death; and

WHEREAS Lester Bronson, known affectionately by all his colleagues as "Tiger" Bronson, spent many years of his life in attempting to better his chosen community of Nome, Alaska and the state; and

WHEREAS, through his many activities in Nome and through his service in the Territorial Legislature of Alaska as well as his service as a member of both the Alaska State Senate and House of Representatives, he will forever be remembered as a man dedicated to public service, contributing greatly to the development of Nome and the state; and

WHEREAS Lester "Tiger" Bronson was always an individual quick to laugh, but equally quick to stand up for his rights and the rights of others; and

WHEREAS his passing is lamented by Alaskans from every walk of life and from every area of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature expresses its most sincere expression of grief at the untimely death of Lester "Tiger" Bronson, but affirms its belief that Alaska and Alaskans have been enriched because of his presence.
