## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 102

Proposing an amendment to the civil rights section of the Constitution of the State of Alaska.

\*\*\*\*\*

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. Sec. 3, art. I of the Constitution of the State of Alaska is amended to read:

SECTION 3. CIVIL RIGHTS. No person is to be denied the enjoyment of any civil or political right because of race, color, creed, sex, or national origin. The legislature shall implement this section.

\* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the state election laws.
