## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 129

Extending thanks to the Seattle Symphony Orchestra.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Seattle Symphony Orchestra is making an historic tour of Alaska, performing in some 18 Alaska cities over a period of seven days; and

WHEREAS it is estimated that this tour by the Seattle Symphony will afford 90 per cent of the population of Alaska with the opportunity of hearing the orchestra, and for many of these Alaskans it marks the first appearance of a truly professional group of musicians in their communities; and

WHEREAS the arranging of such a tremendous undertaking has involved innumerable persons and organizations who have unstintingly devoted unselfishly their time, money and expertise in making this historic tour possible; and

WHEREAS Alaskans everywhere are deeply appreciative of and gratified by these efforts and of the rare opportunity to attend a performance of this magnificent group;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that it expresses its thanks on behalf of all Alaskans to those many individuals and organizations responsible for this memorable experience.
