## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 4

Relating to the Lathrop Malemites winning the state basketball crown.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the Lathrop High School Malemites, Western Alaska basketball champions, have met the Juneau-Douglas Bears, the Southeastern Alaska champions, to compete for the state basketball title; and
