HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 9

Urging that the University of Alaska's history of low resident tuition be continued.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the University of Alaska has operated since its inception in 1917 on a virtual resident-free tuition basis; and

WHEREAS the University and students have been put to the test during these many long and lean years; and

WHEREAS the wisdom of this policy has made itself only too clear with the accomplishments of resident students; and

WHEREAS solid funding of the University is now possible for the first time in its long history due to the recently discovered mineral wealth of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the University of Alaska is urged not to depart from the course of wisdom which they have pursued for over half a century in providing virtually tuition-free higher education to Alaskan residents.
