SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 22

Relating to the designation of the Anchorage-Fairbanks highway as the E.L. "Bob" Bartlett Memorial Highway.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS E.L. "Bob" Bartlett served Alaska and Alaskans for over three decades as a delegate to Congress and United States Senator; and

WHEREAS he was, throughout his career, responsible for the introduction and passage of untold numbers of legislative proposals that contributed and continue to contribute to the growth and well-being of Alaska and its citizens; and

WHEREAS Bob Bartlett was one of the foremost men, if not the foremost, responsible for Alaska taking its rightful place among the Union of these United States; and

WHEREAS the new Anchorage-Fairbanks highway stands as a symbol of the progress of Alaska that Bob believed in so strongly and signals the state's continued and future enhancement of life for its citizens; and

WHEREAS it would be most fitting that this highway, a monument to the ingenuity and perseverance of modern mankind, stand as a permanent reminder of the good works of this most esteemed and loved Alaskan;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Commissioner of Highways to designate the new Anchorage-Fairbanks highway as the E.L. "Bob" Bartlett Memorial Highway.
