## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41

Relating to the "Midnight Sun 600" snowmobile classic.

**BE IT RESOLVED**

**BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

WHEREAS the "Midnight Sun 600" snowmobile race, which has been run between Anchorage and Fairbanks for the past few years, has become one of the most popular events in the state; and

WHEREAS this classic event is a true contest of man's will and determination as well as a test of the highest magnitude for the machines involved; and

WHEREAS Alaskans from all corners of the state follow the progress of the racers and have voiced their enthusiastic support for this snowmobile classic; and

WHEREAS it has been alleged that this year's event is to be the last race which would be run over the public highway between Anchorage and Fairbanks; and

WHEREAS the inconvenience caused the motoring public is negligible and of short duration;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Departments of Highways and Public Safety to permit the continuance each year of the "Midnight Sun 600", utilizing the Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway, upon request of the appropriate Midnight Sun officials provided that the public safety and welfare can be protected.
