## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 74

Encouraging the BLM to release the presently designated Campbell Airstrip land with stipulations for its highest and best use.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS land comprising that portion of the Campbell Airstrip area declared surplus by the military is soon to be released to the state by the Bureau of Land Management; and

WHEREAS it is universally acknowledged that sound land planning must accompany the opening up of land areas in the public interest; and

WHEREAS large portions of the Campbell Airstrip land are most suitable for recreational purposes and are important for water table recharge;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature respectfully recommends that the Bureau of Land Management release the designated Campbell Airstrip land to the state with the stipulation that it be held in reserve status until such time as it can be utilized under land planning principles which recognize its highest and best use.
