AN ACT

Relating to burial of body.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 12.65.100 is amended to read:

Sec. 12.65.100. BURIAL OF BODY. When a coroner holds an inquest upon a body, and no friend or relative appears to claim the body for burial, and no provision is made for the body under AS 13.50, the coroner shall notify the Department of Health and Social Services which shall cause the body to be plainly and decently buried or cremated and the remains decently interred.
