AN ACT

Relating to the licensing of marine pilots.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.62.130 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.62.130. LAPSED LICENSE. A lapsed license may be reinstated without examination if it has not remained lapsed for more than two years. However, if the license is lapsed for less than two years and the board has reason to believe that the person applying for reinstatement of his license is incapable or incompetent to carry out the duties of a licensed marine pilot, the board may require the applicant to take and pass the examination given by the board.
