AN ACT

Relating to threats and false reports of bombing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.45 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.45.055. THREATS AND FALSE REPORTS OF BOMBING.

- (a) A person who wilfully and maliciously threatens to throw, place, or discharge a bomb or other explosive or incendiary device which could reasonably be expected to (1) do bodily harm to a person or (2) damage the property of a person, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or by imprisonment for not less than one year nor more than five years, or by both.
- (b) A person who makes a false report, with the intent to deceive, mislead, or otherwise misinform a person, concerning the placing, planting or discharging of a bomb or other explosive or incendiary device, upon conviction, is punishable as provided in (a) of this section.
