AN ACT

Increasing the membership of the Board of Fish and Game.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.220 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.220. THE BOARD OF FISH AND GAME. There is created a Board of Fish and Game composed of 12 members having a general knowledge of the fish and game resources of the state and selected without regard to political affiliation or special interest. Each member of the board shall be a United States citizen and a resident of the state. Members of the board are appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session.

* Sec. 2. AS 16.05.230 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.230. TERM OF OFFICE. The term of office for members of the board is four years. The first members appointed serve as follows: two members shall serve for one year, two for two years, two for three years, and four for four years, respectively. The eleventh and twelfth members appointed shall serve terms of two and four years, respectively. Initial terms date from the first of February immediately preceding appointment. If a vacancy occurs, the governor shall fill it by appointment for the unexpired term. The appointment shall be submitted to the legislature for confirmation at the next regular or special session.

* Sec. 3. AS 16.05.320 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.320. QUORUM. A majority of the members of the board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of

business, for the performance of any duty, and for the exercise of any power. However, a majority of the full board membership of 12 members is required to carry all motions, regulations and resolutions.
