HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 62

Relating to a study of the corrections system in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS in recent years there have been discussion and concern regarding the corrections system in Alaska; and

WHEREAS many people have expressed their opinion as to the proper location of the correctional function in state government; and

WHEREAS various plans have been suggested, and bills have been introduced to change the structure of the division of corrections; and

WHEREAS, before any final determinations are made, a definitive objective study by knowledgeable persons in the field of criminal justice should be conducted; and

WHEREAS the National Conference on Criminal Justice has released its standards for the criminal justice system;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that the Legislative Council is requested to conduct an interim study of the corrections system with the objective of recommending to the Eighth Legislature - Second Session any changes in the present structure.
