## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 2

Honoring Irwin L. "Irv" Metcalf.

**BE IT RESOLVED**

**BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

WHEREAS Irwin L. Metcalf, former state and territorial legislator, has met an untimely death; and

WHEREAS "Irv" Metcalf spent many years of his life in attempting to better his community of Seward, Alaska, and the state; and

WHEREAS, through his many activities in Seward and through his service in the Territorial Legislature of Alaska as well as his service as a member of the Alaska State Senate, the Alaska State House of Representatives and the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly, he will forever be remembered as a man dedicated to public service, contributing greatly to the development of his community and state; and

WHEREAS, as a delegate to the Constitutional Convention, "Irv" played a major role in the development of Alaska's very existence as a state; and

WHEREAS his passing is lamented by Alaskans from every walk of life and from every area of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature expresses its most sincere expression of grief at the untimely death of Irwin L. "Irv" Metcalf, but affirms its belief that Alaska and Alaskans have been enriched because of his presence.
